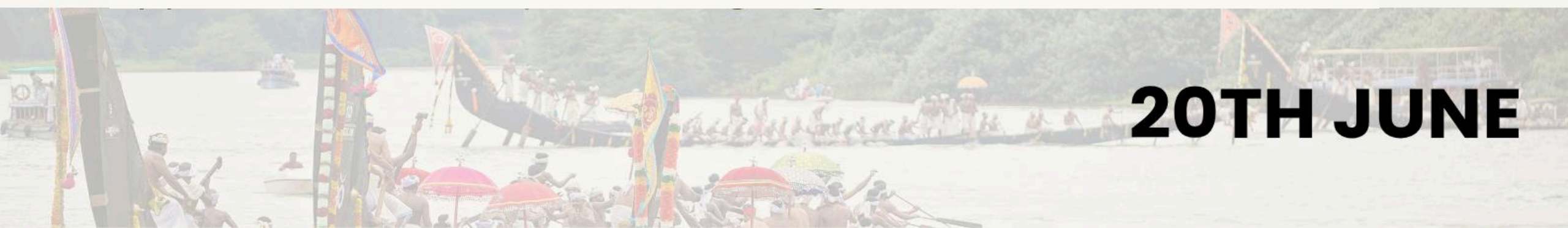


MALAYALAM FORUM AT SISAD : ENRICHING LANGUAGE TEACHING THROUGH COLLABORATION
