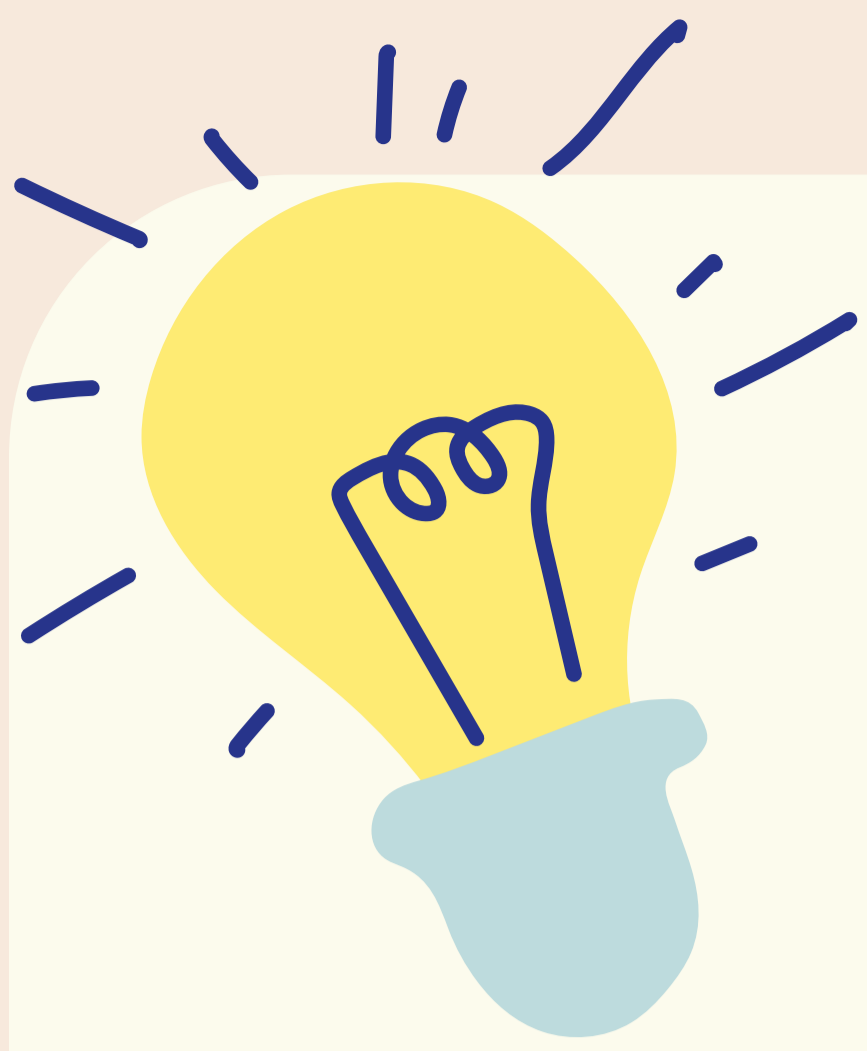

Standard Benchmark Assessment



ASSET



School: Sunrise International School

Assessment Period: February 2, 2026 – February 10, 2026

Overview

The assessment evaluated 2,705 students across Grades 3 through 9 in English, Mathematics, and Science. The overall participation was excellent, with 99.6% of registered students completing the tests.

Key Findings

Subject Strengths: English is the school's strongest subject, maintaining high average scaled scores (overall mean of 519) and high percentages of advanced learners (Stanine 6+), particularly in Class 9 (56.3%).

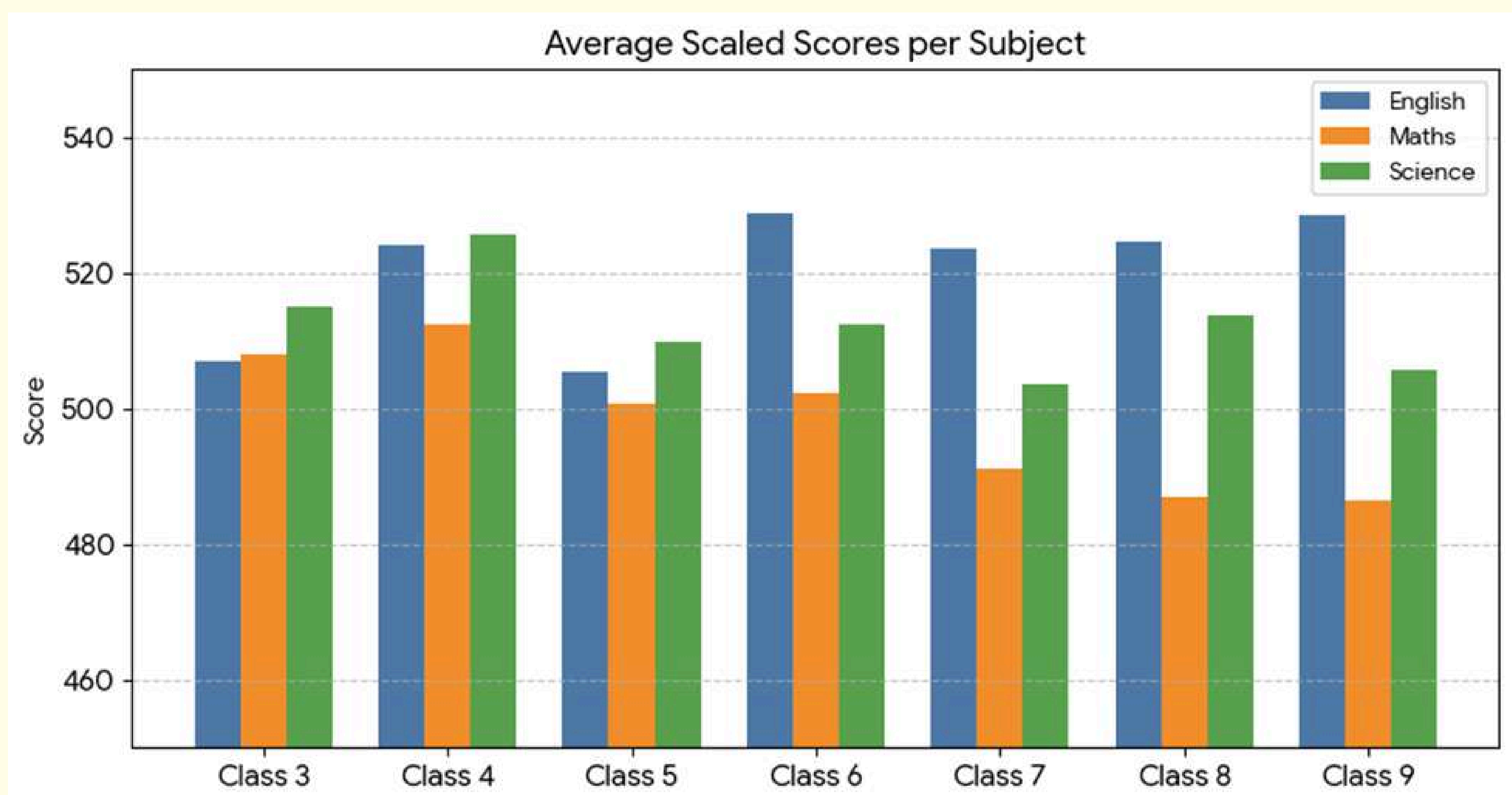
Mathematics Trend: There is a noticeable decline in Mathematics performance as students move into higher grades. Average scores drop from 508 in Class 3 to 486.5 in Class 9, with the percentage of proficient students (Stanine 5+) falling from 68.8% to 55.5% in the same period.

Science Stability: Science performance remains consistent across the school, with a mean score of 513.1. Proficiency levels are highest in the younger years, peaking at 76.6% in Class 4.

Top Performing Grade: Class 4 demonstrated the strongest combined performance across all subjects, showing high levels of both general proficiency and advanced achievement.

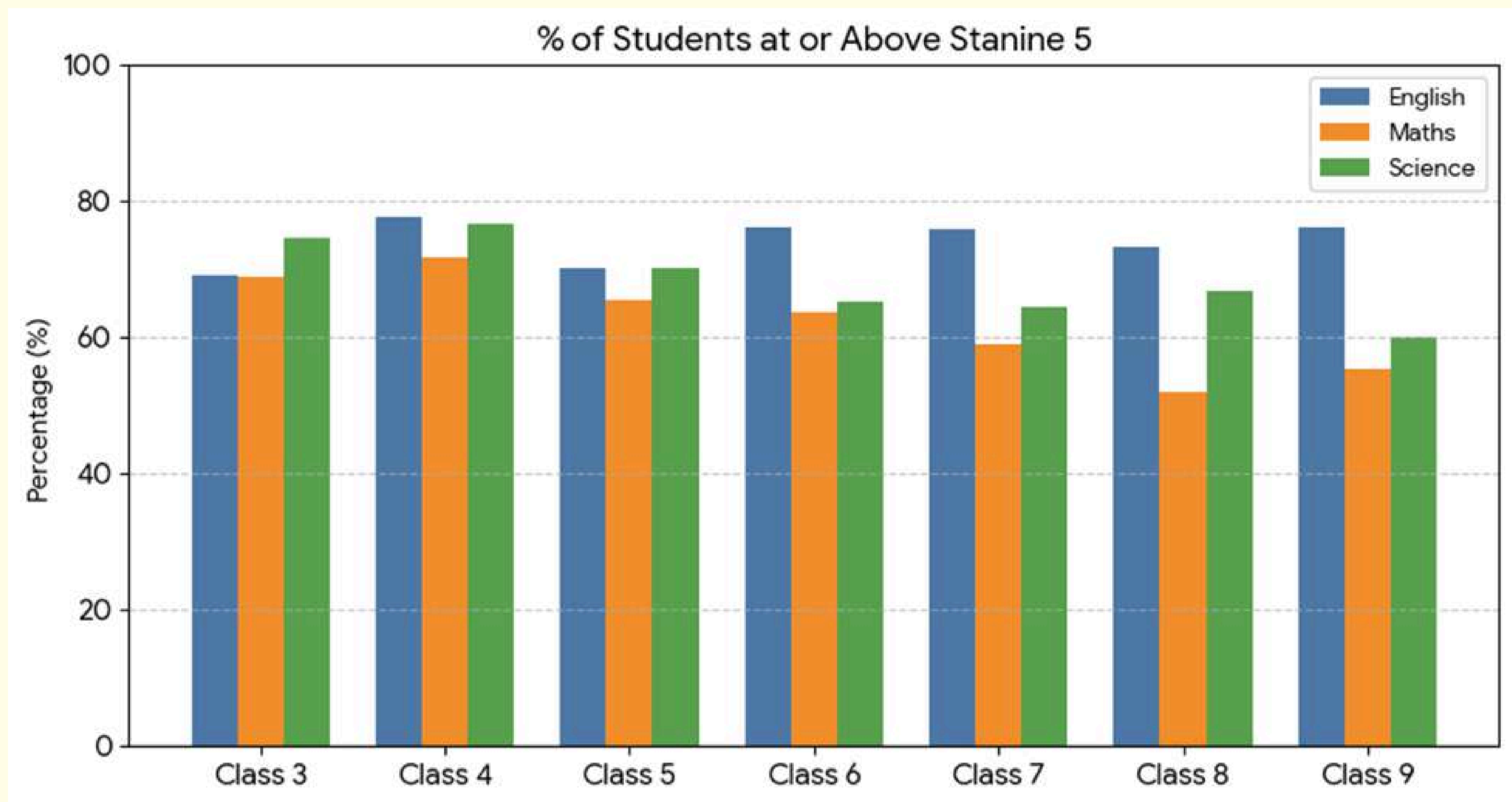
1. Average Scaled Scores

This graph shows the mean performance for each class across English, Maths, and Science.



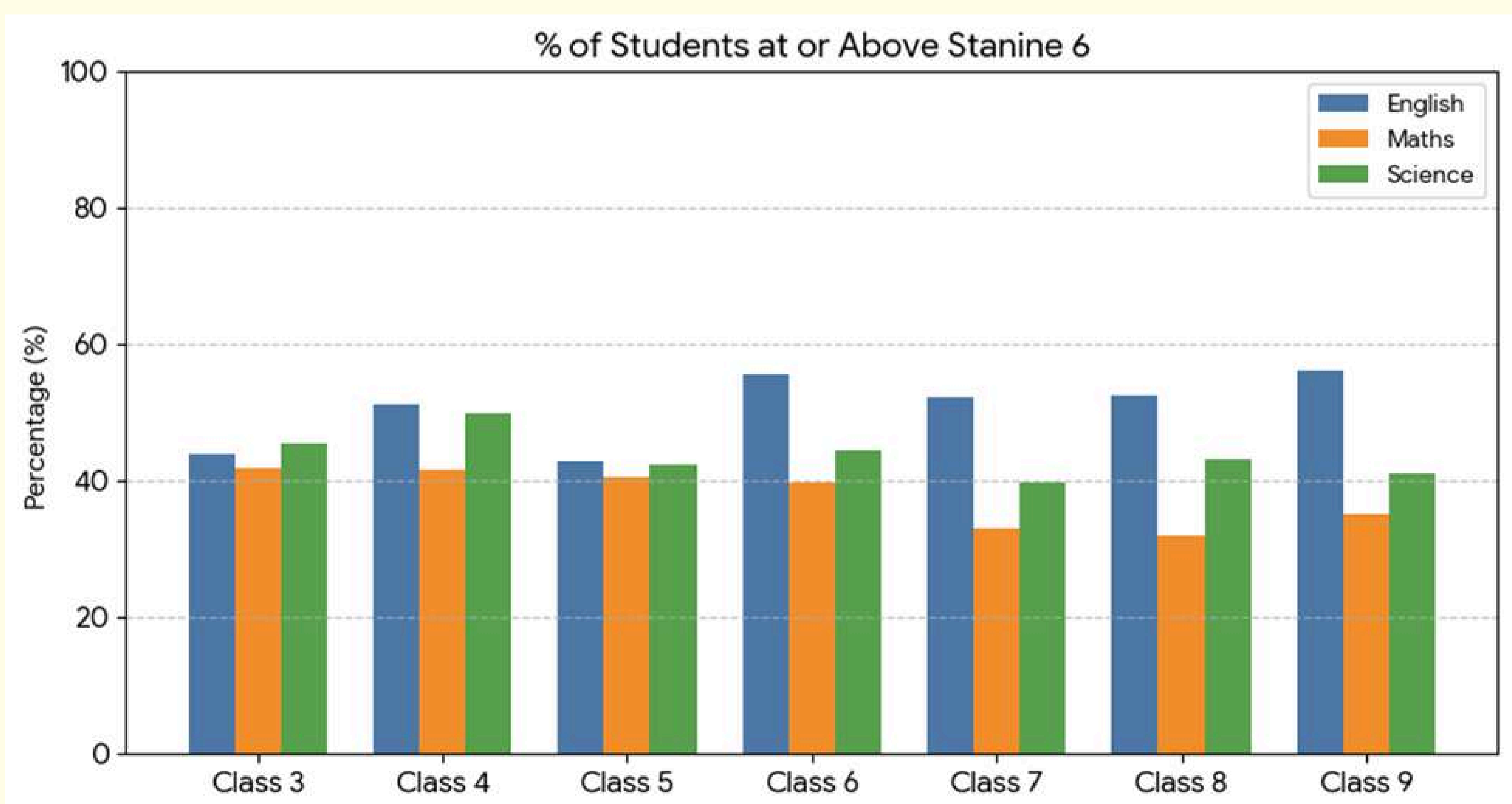
2. Proficiency (Stanine 5 and Above)

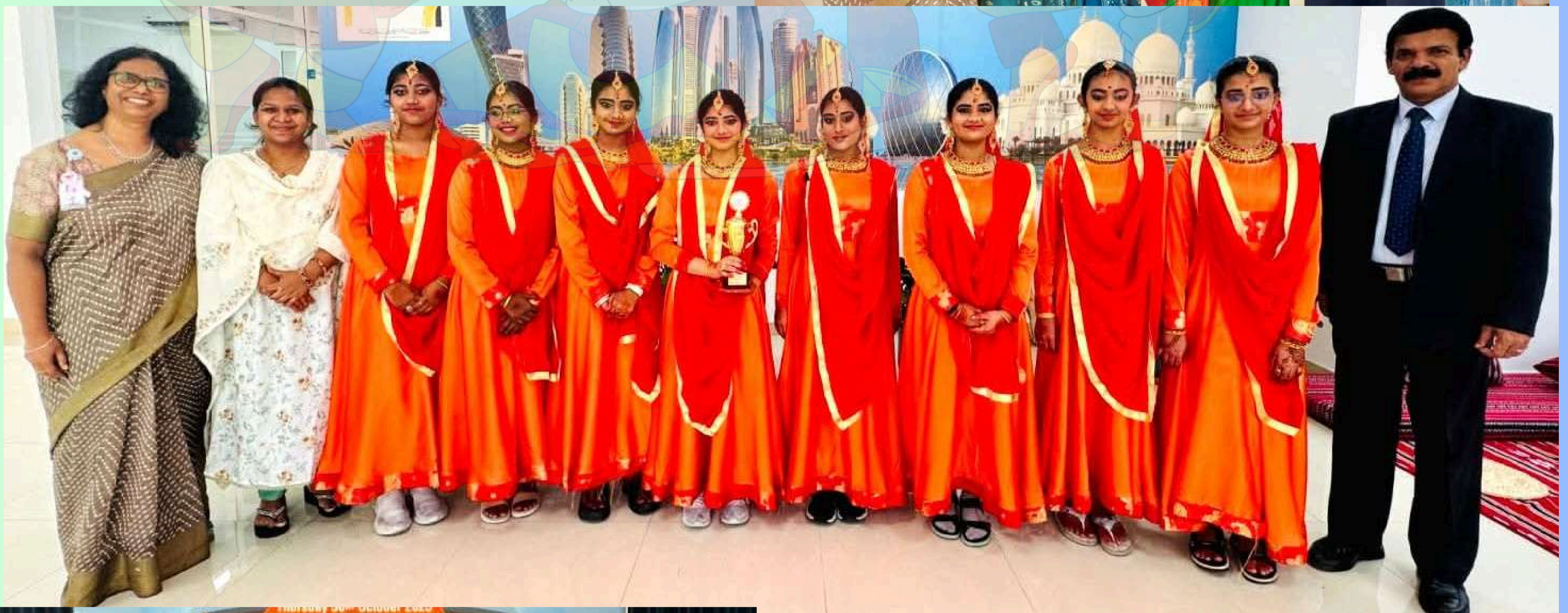
